

Calvary Indoor Worship Instructions and Information

Indoor worship will begin at Calvary UM in the sanctuary on June 7 at 9:30 AM.

The worship service will also continue to be provided on Facebook.

When arriving for worship, you must enter through the front doors or the handicap accessible entrance so you can be SIGNED IN. DO NOT USE THE BACK DOOR.

Greeters will sign you in and provide you with hand sanitizer.

You MUST wear a FACE COVERING/MASK while in the church. If you do not have one, the church will provide one for you upon sign in.

OBSERVE SPECIAL SEATING arrangements. Seating will be in every other pew. Sit only on the pews that have BLUE TAPE on them designating where to sit.

There will be no hymnals or Bibles in the pews. The projector will be used.

There will be music but NO singing.

Observe SOCIAL DISTANCING practices. Always maintain 6-feet from others.

Visit/greet others at a distance only. Wave to greet others and make no physical contact with others.

Only one person in a bathroom at a time.

There will be no communion offered during this reopening phase.

Other Church Instructions:

If you need something from the church office throughout the week, CALL FIRST to plan/schedule your visit.

Even throughout the week, any time you enter the church, you MUST wear a mask.

At this time we are offering Sunday worship and Tai Chi, only. We will, also, continue to participate in our bi-monthly Red Cross blood drives. Other activities and events will be slowly added as we progress through different phases.

There will be no VBS this year.

Pies have been postponed for now.
